## Institute Policy on Scholarship and Freeships

Sanskrithi Group of Institutions, under the visionary leadership of Chairman Sri Vijay Bhaskar Reddy, is committed to recognizing and rewarding exceptional achievements in education. The institution firmly believes in providing financial assistance and support to deserving students, especially those from low-income families in rural areas of Puttaparthi. The following scholarships have been established to encourage and empower students:

- 1. Sai Prudent Scholarship (SPS): Instituted in 2010 with the support of Anahata Stiftung and RISE, Austria, this program aims to provide financial aid to economically disadvantaged students, ensuring that their educational aspirations are not hindered by financial constraints. Over the past five years, 78 students have benefited from the Sai Prudent Scholarship, with a total expenditure of INR 47,10,000.
- 2. Andhra Pradesh Government Scholarships: The Government of Andhra Pradesh offers post-matric scholarships to eligible students belonging to SC, ST, BC, EBC (other than Kapu), Kapu, Minority, and Differently Abled categories on a saturation basis. The scholarships include:

  Jagananna Vidya Deevena: This scheme provides full fee reimbursement, including tuition fees, special fees, other fees, and exam fees, to eligible students. The reimbursement is credited directly to the respective college accounts on behalf of the students.

  Jagananna Vasathi Deevena: Under this scheme, eligible students receive Rs. 20,000 per year for food and hostel expenses. The amount is credited to the account of the student's mother or natural guardian.
- 3. National Scholarship Portal (NSP) Scholarship: Scholarships are awarded by the Department of Higher Education through the National Scholarship Portal, Eligible students who have secured more than 50% marks in the previous final examination and whose parents' annual income does not exceed I lakh are eligible to receive a scholarship amount of Rs. 10,000 per annum for UG courses.
- 4. Rural Development Trust (RDT) Scholarship: Candidates who have completed their 10th class education and meet the minimum percentage requirements in relevant subjects can apply for the RDT scholarship. The eligibility criteria may vary based on the course being
