



Summary report on scholarships and freeships

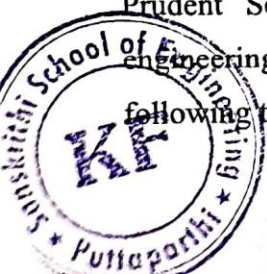
Scholarships and freeships are forms of financial aid that help students cover the costs of their education. Scholarships are typically merit-based, while freeships are need-based. Sanskrithi's Sai Prudent Scholarship is awarded based on financial need and is only offered to incoming SSE students who are pursuing an Engineering. The Sai Prudent Scholarship Program also enables these students to emerge as young professionals in the future.


Freeships, on the other hand, are typically awarded based on financial need. Students from low-income families, or those who demonstrate financial hardship, may be eligible for freeships. Freeships can cover tuition fees, accommodation costs, or other expenses related to education. During the year 2017-18, the management contributed a total of Rs. 13,93,000 and 98 students could benefit from this contribution. During the year 2018-19, a sum of Rs. 23,07,000 was contributed and benefited 164 students. In the year 2019-20, the management at sanskrithi contributed a total of Rs. 33,14,750, which again benefited 249 students. Similarly in the year 2020-21, the freeship contribution summed up to Rs. 42,40,000 benefiting 238 students and in the year the total contribution was Rs. 43,72,950 and benefited 201 students. The same data is reflected in the table below:

In sanskrithi school of engineering students must meet certain criteria to be considered for the Sai Prudent Scholarship. During the last five years several students from sanskrithi school of engineering qualified for Jagananna Vidya Deevana, the government scholarship scheme. From this 800 students 81 students qualified for sai prudent scholarships. Students qualified for Jagananna Vidya Deevena and Jagananna Vasathi Deevena are considered for sai prudent scholarship also.

Through sai prudent scholarship students are getting eligibility to stay in sanskrithi's hostels without paying anything. This is a blessing for the students who are struggling financially.

Every year the college will increase the sai prudent scholarship amount also. During the last five years the Anahata foundation spent around 4370000 for the sai prudent scholarship program.

During the 2017-18 academic year the Anahata foundation spent Rs. 1215000 for scholarships and 27 students benefited, during the 2018-19 academic year Anahata foundation spent Rs. 400000 and 8 students benefited from it. For the 2019-20 batch Anahata foundation spent Rs. 935000 and 17 students benefited from it, 2020-21 Anahata's spent amount was Rs. 780000 and 13 students benefited from it.
